Furthermore the University "Mediterranea" boasts a prestigious Postgraduate Specialisation School for Legal Professions designed for people who want to make a career as an ordinary magistrate, a lawyer, or a notary. To this are added postgraduate courses, Training and Higher Education Courses, off-campus activities, and experiences in the national and international territory that represent the proper completion of university life. All the scheduled activities aim at improving services for students (scholarships and refectories) and guaranteeing the right to study also taking into account different income brackets.





The most deserving students who fulfil the requirements set out in the relevant Official Call, are entitled to a place free of charge in the Residence characterized by a comfortable and engaging environment. The Call for Competitions regarding the University Scholarships is regularly issued at the beginning of each academic year.

The University "Mediterranea" through its Disability Services Office, is committed to providing equal and integrated access for individuals with disabilities by identifying their most urgent needs and providing the most suitable technical equipment and special tuition.



THE UNIVERSITY CAMPUS

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The University Campus is located on Feo di Vito hills and includes 5 Departments, 80 Laboratories, and well-organized facilities for students.

The Department of Architecture and Design feature large and comfortable spaces including rooms, a Library, Auditorium, multimedia Laboratory, and an elegant Atelier where some interesting archaeological remains by kind and exclusive concession of the Archaeological Calabrian Superintendence concerned, are on display. The near "Lotto D" Building features a large area dedicated to Law, Economics and Human Science Department, to some offices and students facilities (such as some students' secretariats, Orientation, Disabled People).

The complex of the Engineering Departments contains an Auditorium and a Library which are very comfortable and well-designed.

The complex of the Department of Agriculture is set on top of Feo di Vito hill and is made up of two buildings both connected to a big atrium by a wide courtyard that seamlessly blends with the surrounding landscape.
